Sebastes vexillaris: 1 ad., with considerable red suffusion; large eye + high, excised H. spines - To public aquarium. Originally reddish brown, brown in dark areas, yellower in light, but general tone is dull reddish. By III: 18 color had gradually changed until ~~III: 18~~ III: 18 (over)

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lightest ~~color~~ areas of the lower
surfaces, and the oblique saddle
below 1st 10. were nearly white;

the darker areas of the more pigmented
~~spots~~ parts of the ~~silvery~~ were then
deep, rich brown, with little red, and
the lighter areas were definitely yellow.

The appearance is now quite unlike
that of original fish.
