Color description: Larger spec: gold (orange) band on anterior edge of mandible. Orange band extending through eye to mandible. First dorsal with gold patch in center. Gold around base of pectorals, gold ~~spot~~ spot on anterior portion of anal, pelvis gold, gold tint on caudal peduncle, gold patch near ventral edge of caudal.

Smaller spec: narrow gold band from eye anterior to mandible - pelvis gold, gold tint on caudal peduncle.
