Not very common. Blue color slender  
form and erratic movements  
make identification clear. When  
much disturbed make off by skips  
at surface. One did so many times in  
very rapid succession.

*Cypselurus californicus*: several  
ads. came to light. 1 speared (not  
preserved). 2 speared later in  
night.

40. Atherinops affinis californensis:  
52. speared but all broke in 2  
except 1 (saved). Fairly common  
at times.

Leuresthes tenuis: 12d. speared

1 hl. gr. speared, but escaped  
at surface
