Deep purplish red, darker before +
above a light oblique streak
extending from junction of dorsals
to between P₁ + P₂. A few silvery
blue spots along edge of light bar
+ a few on lower sides. 2 light

on back behind ear; especially
bright blue spot on upper end
of P₁ axial & another at base of
caudal. All fins banded
with deep red & transparent
bluish.
