filaments, ^{thin} flattish interorbital
& rather trim form; 1, weak,
preserved in evening; other put
in aquarium temporarily.

Third, largest specimen, greenish,
but with underlying reddish tone;
flesh of mouth deep green, but
form of body + thickness of fins
much as in others - Possibly a hybrid.
Specimen put in refrigerator for work
on bones; to be measured, weighed
& vertebrae dissected out, so
rest can be saved.
