mostly in territorial crevices, a
few on top of submerged rocks.
50. *Pimelometopon pulchrum*: sev. hl. gr. - ad,
close to bottom.
- Oxygnathus californicus*: sev. hl. gr. - ad, mostly
in mid water, one nibbling on boulder.
51. *Girella nigricans*: a few hl. gr. - ad.
