55(A) Scopelogadus marmoratus (Garnet intergrade) 1 (290)

Color: D, mottled dark rose with clear spaces & small white markings; a triangular black blotch on fin near edge of fin on spines of 6, 7, 8, & 9 & on membranes. Body mottled with dark rose red blotches, small white blotches on a rose red ground color above mid-line. 5 white dashes (longitudinal) along mid-line, absent on peduncle. Lower 1/2 of body lighter rose red fading to coral on belly with pronounced white spots between pectoral & caudal peduncle. Pectoral fin more or less banded with dark rose & light rose with some white blackish toward base of fin. Large distinct white spot at posterior base of pectoral. Gular area ground white with pinkish wash. Ventrals with orange rose ray, membranes blackish between edged with light rose. Anal spines tipped with white & anteriorly edged with orange-tan. Spines membranes dark orange-tan. ~~At middle~~ rows of irregular whitish orange dots on spines.

D₂ dark rose flecked with light
rose spots - darkest at edge

Head mottled dark rose & light
rose with diagonal white line (diffuse)
near anterior base of D₁, white at
dorsal opening of gills, vertical white
line under eye - eye rose, maxillary
dark rose - black. Inside lower jaw
& mouth bright orange-red.
