Rather rich cherry brown almost uniform over body and top of head. Cheeks and especially lower part of opercle salmon. 2 blackish lines behind eye with pearly borders. Conspicuous (over)

blackish shoulder spot. Dark streaks behind eye with pearly borders and pearly cross-markings on chin.

D. + A. slightly redder than body. Cream colored spots and bars on A. + C. Pectoral with red brown and bluish gray bars.
