53. *Sebastes chrysomelas*: 1 ad. General color brown with considerable gold ventrally. Light areas creamy white above grading through light tan to flesh color. Faint bands largely green. D. green on membranes pinkish.

53. *Sebastes vexillaris*: 1 ad. (tagged), 215-240 mm. DMD on ray

Pink brown ground color with trace of golden orange on outer parts of scales. Basal triangle of scales sooty blue over dark areas. Light saddle between third and fourth dorsal spines, bluish white. Small light areas below middle of spinous dorsal yellow-cream. Light spots below junction of dorsals bluish white. Light streak along lateral line posteriorly grading from cream forward to pale dusky orange posteriorly. Mid. sides flecked with brown and dirty orange. Mandibles pinkish white lower lip rather bright yellow. Fins mostly orange brown. Only a little pink on sides of face. Lower surface considerable with rather strong wash of orange-pink.
