57. Aulorhynchus flavidus: 4 egg masses close
together, on strings of Phyllospadix wrapped
around cables about 1 1/2" apart. Found when
lifting temperature instrument. The eggs had
obviously been deposited on the Phyllospadix,
not on a piece of Macrocytis stipe that was
intertwined with the surf-grass. Eggs were not
noticed when gear was briefly lifted for inspection
about 4 p.m. III:10.
