Wisner dropped by at 120 to get more specimens, but none were viable. Mr. Lytle said that water was full of the larvae early in the morning, but that they thinned out as sun got higher. Mr. DeWitt of Ocean Fish Protective Association called earlier, said Mr. Lytle, to report great concentration of larvae thought by some to be sardines but his description suggested Atherinops. Fish were taken first to SFA, then brought to Grace L. Utter V. 6: 1952
