A crustacean which appears to be one of the moulting stages of our lobster was taken by the surface under the light. It has many of the characteristics of an adult. The antennae are proportionally larger and the eyes more to the sides.

In life the animal was a transparent very pale green with a slight pink cast to the margins. It was swimming backwards with its antennae touching and close together. The eyes appeared to be black.
