Dip-netted quite a few larval "ship-jack"
- also caught dolphin, half-harks, Oxypterocheilus,
small flying fishes. Caught one small pelagic
crab. Large dolphin under light. Attempted
unsuccessfully to dip net small (12-16")
sea turtle without success. Dip-netted 2-3
small myctophids. Quite often 12" squid under
light.

Water thick with water anemones and other
minute crustacea among which the small
scorpaenids were feeding. Nocturnal fish swam
under light but escaped net.
