3 L + 1 B; counts taken in 3 smaller.  
Smallest (342 mm SL) fresh is complete  
ambicolorate with short black at front  
of D; this one preserved; others eaten.  
The 2 other smaller specimens, 356 and 411  
mm SL (fresh) each contained 2 squid (Loligo  
opalescens).
