XII:13:1957

Speth, Muller, Moran, Harrison, Newcomb
landed at "Elephant Seal Beach" to go to
top of mt, along ridge and down to NE
Anchorage. (3 day trip)

C. L. H., L. C. H., Stover in Wizard; Flecksig,
Kelly, Pournelle, Chace in tuna tender,
circled north end of island and rendezvoused
with Stranger at W Anch. ^{about} 1530.

Stranger with Wisner, trawled on NW
side of Guadalupe.
Overnight at West Anchorage.

XII: 14: 1957

Midnight till 0600 Trawl to SE of Island.
Return to So. of Isote Negro.

0900 C.L.H., L.C.H. and Flechsig landed on
Isote Negro by Stover. Then Stover,
Kelly and Pournelle returned to W. anch.
to pick up trap set overnight and to
make sl. seal census from anch. to
point W. of weather station.

Stranger used shell dredge S. of Isote Negro.

All assembled on Stranger for lunch.

P.M. Stover and Flechsig attempt electric
reel fishing from ^{off West Anchorage} ~~Wizall~~ Stranger
pulled dredge ^{in West Anchorage area.}

Bad storm developed, moved over to
Milpangue Cove for night, after circling Outer Islet
(Isote Negro) + Ocean Sealions.
C.L.H., L.C.H. and Pournelle to weather Sta
to pick up temp. record and leave candy
and toys.

XII: 15: 1957

0100 - 0645 Midwater trawl East side
Guadalupe I.

High winds developed, ran past 2
beaches to see if shore party down yet.
Plan of plan to run fur seal count this day.
1100 to 1430 Trawl on East side of
Guadalupe I.

at 1600 - 1630 Return to NE anch. all 5 of
shore party walking. Taken off in high
surf and also ^{retrieved} cached material on
both beaches. All of party on board.

XII:16:1957

Anchored at NE Anchorage till about
midnight then trawled ⁰⁰⁵⁵ out and
trawled so. along east side till about 0600

0800 CLH, LCH and Stover in Wizard
make fur seal census ^{from lobster camp north} meeting Stranger
at NE Anch about 1400

0800 Moran and Newcomb landed ^{by skiff} at lobster
camp for botanizing, Chace for molluscs.
Attempt to get tuna tender operating fails.
Stranger returns to old sealing station
to leave Harbison for overnight and to
walk to weather sta. (2 day operation).
Fleehing, Pownall, Spill and Kelly
did some looking at fur seals with
skiff in lobster camp area.

Ab. 1430 Wisner did electric seal fishing off
Cinder cone.

Ab. 1430 All but Harbison on board Stranger.
Stranger returns to lobster camp to
pick up shore party. Some circling
to watch large school of black fish.

Ab. 1500 CLH, LCH and Stover in Wizard to
check shore from lobster camp to
Melponene Cove. Fleehing picks up
Moran, Chace and Newcomb and
then Stranger returns to Melponene Cove
all but Harbison on board for night.
Stranger lay to off Cinder Cone. Too much
drift for fishing. Smart breeze developing.

XII. 17. 1957

~~From~~ midnight till 0600 midwater trawls

So and E. of Guadalupe I.

Stranger returns to old sealing camp.

at 0800 - Spieth and Muller put on shore
by Stover. Heavy gear of Harrison's picked
up and brought on boat.

Hulls, Chase and Stover in Wizard to travel
along E. shore looking for coguina.

Stranger moved to lobster camp.

0900 Moran put ashore at lobster camp
Fleching, Pournelle, Newcomb and
Kelly with tuna tender and skiff
to photograph furseals.

0915 Wisner, electric ref fixing of Stranger
off lobster camp.

1130-1245 Hulls, Chase and Stover in for lunch
then left in Wizard to check on coguina
around lobster camp.

Furseal party, Pournelle, Fleching, Kelly,
returned to count furseal.

Rendezvous to be at 1630 at lobster
camp, where pick up Moran

1500 Fur seal group aboard

1600 Coguina workers aboard

1630 Moran aboard. Ship headed for
Melpomene Cove.

1800 Harrison, Muller and Spieth aboard.
Entire party aboard for the night.

57, 2nd. 3rd and pros. 3
XII:18, 1927 Tattlers. Sun low

0300 moved out of Melpanene
Cove to try out Isaacs' new high
speed net. Trawled on E. side of
Island.

0730 when net in very rough,
high swells, white caps, etc. Moved
"Stranger" from Melpanene Cove over
to W. side of Island to see about
landing at Salote negro or West
Anchorage. Both impossible. Returned
to Melpanene Cove. ab. 0945 Moran,
Harbison and Flecksig landed at
weather sta. for the day. Ship to
dredge in Cove. Shell dredge
unproductive. One pipe dredge
hauled, no fish. Dredge lost on
second haul. Anchored about 1600,

1630 Shore party on board. Report their
supply ship overdue. Taking out
flour, etc.

ca 1900 weighed anchor and set out for hydrog. station.

XII:18-20 From late evening of XII:18 until
arrival at San Diego Customs about
0930 on XII:20, with all aboard, worked
hydrographic stations in sequence, as
per request from John D. Isaacs
et al.
