 4 young to half-grown, 16 mm 26-38 mm S.L.;
 recognized by relatively robust form, coloration
 longish jaws, shoulder girdle in one with a
 dorsal fin remaining. Smallest one doubtful
 59(8). Cleodandia ioo (Jordan & Gilbert):
 1 half-grown 25 mm S.L.; recognized by very
 slender form, very long jaws, rounded
 occiput, and trace of color.
