 (Some saved for frozen bait, much of "galley")

Included also 2 specimens of Bregmaceros, a
 deep-bodied bothid prejuvenile, 1 Leptocottalus,
 moderate series of a tiny Sciaenid (Cynoscion
sp. ?), some used for parasite study (very
 surprisingly, these tiny fish had mature
 gonads); also 1 Monolene and a few
 specimens of Brutuloides and of a stromateid.
